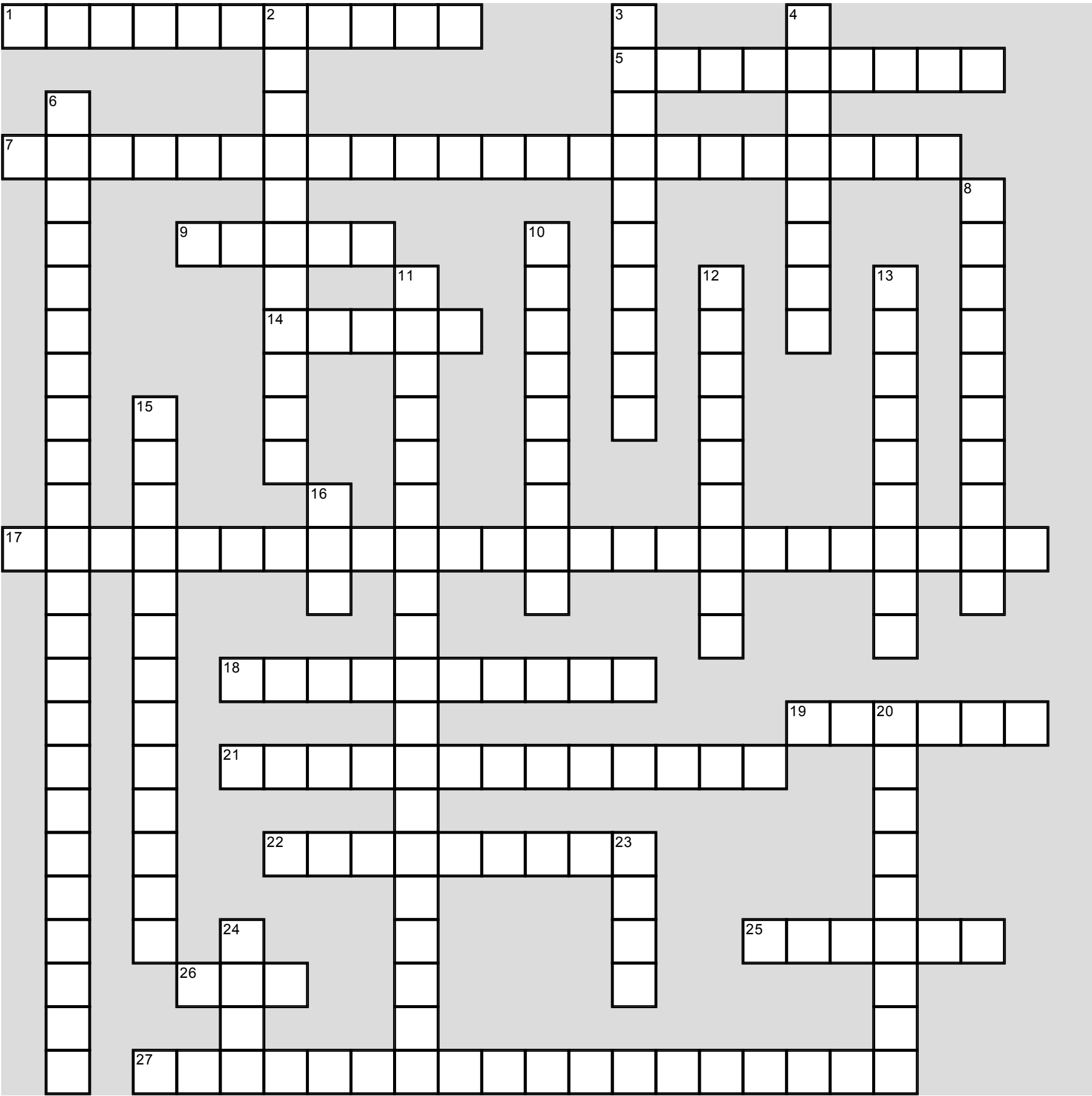

- 22 Living and Learning Community that provides opportunities for people with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)
- 25 DHM Mission Center located in Washington that enhances the well being of children and youth through advocacy and education that is both local and global in nature
- 26 Vision: all children have homes where hope is kindled and dreams can be achieved; Abbr.
- 27 A fully planned youth mission/poverty education experience. Youth join youth from other churches across the country to explore issues of culture, gender, and poverty in an urban setting.

- 2 Leads poverty education for the non-poor, helping people of faith experience and understand the systemic roots of economic oppression, to become better neighbors in a hurting world
- 3 An outreach project based at Edinburg Christian Church, with the goal of providing help to infants (newborn to 36 months) in Shenandoah County in the form of a week's supply of formula, food, disposable diapers and wet-wipes, plus gently used clothing and baby items
- 4 Located in Denver, CO; works with children, youth and their families to overcome a variety of life crises, including abuse and neglect
- 6 A haven of hope and healing for children, youth and families struggling with mental illness, abuse and neglect
- 8 A comprehensive community center providing a broad spectrum of social services to all, regardless of faith or race, and to empower the community to meet its needs by promoting equality, unity, respect and self-determination among all who participate in its programs
- 10 A day shelter for the homeless, the hungry, and anyone who needs a place of respite and a good meal
- 11 Vision: We are called to care for aging adults – spiritually, physically and mentally
- 12 A Senior Living Community, created in partnership with Centra Health and CC(DOC) in Virginia, to provide an environment for each resident to be "Engaged in Life."
- 13 _____ Fellowship is a church among men and women without homes in Massachusetts, dedicated to ending isolation through pastoral care and nurturing community
- 15 Located in Glendale, AZ, provides quality senior housing and other services to enhance the lives of those we serve in a friendly family-style community environment
- 16 DHM Mission Center that introduces mission groups and volunteers to the people of Appalachia; Abbr.
- 20 A caring team advocating for those with disabilities: Enhancing lives, Respecting individuality, Providing quality opportunities for choice, and Promoting community membership
